\$2,400 (\$600 a year for 4 years)

Eligibility:

Parents or guardians must be a Cherryland Electric customer
Minimum G.P.A. of 2.75

Requirements:

List academic accomplishments, extra-curricular activities, community involvement and after-school employment
Maintain a 2.5 average while attending college with a course load of at least 12 credits

Deadline: April 2, 2010

Grand Traverse Area Retired School Personnel Academic Scholarship

\$1,000

Eligibility:

SAT composite of 1100 or ACT composite of 27
3.5 GPA in academic classes

Requirements:

Complete the scholarship application (available in Student Services office)
Three recommendation forms (provided with application)
High school transcript

Grand Traverse Area Retired School Personnel Vocational Scholarship

\$1,000

Eligibility:

Overall GPA of 2.5

Michigan Community Blood Services Scholarship

\$500

Eligibility:

Be planning to pursue studies in science or health care in college

Requirements:

Complete a 250 word essay about recruiting student donors for blood drives.
Complete the scholarship application (See Student Services)

Munson Medical Center Volunteer Scholarship

Minimum of \$500

Eligibility:

Be a resident of Grand Traverse, Benzie, Leelanau, Kalkaska or Wexford County for at least 6 months prior to high school graduation.
Be pursuing a health-related program of study.

Requirements:

Complete the scholarship application (available in Student Services office)
Essay about your interest in pursuing this career

Tuition Incentive Program

Full tuition for 2 years at a participating Michigan College

Eligibility:

Must have received Medicaid coverage for 24 consecutive months within a 36 month period as identified by the Department of Human Services

Requirements:

Qualifying students usually receive notification from the Office of Scholarships and Grants if they are eligible. If you think you are eligible, but did not receive a letter, or can't find it, see the Student Services office for contact information.
