

How do I apply to MTA?

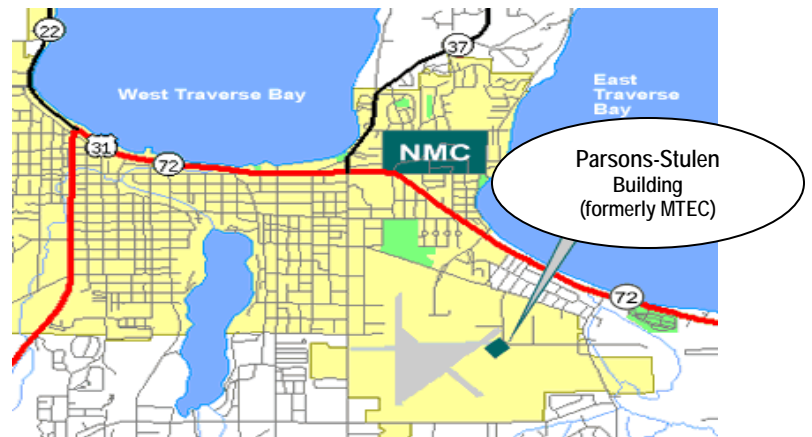


1. Start by visiting MTA. You can do this by...

- Arranging with your high school counselor to visit while MTA is in session, any time between 7:30 and 11:30 am weekdays, and/or
- Attending an MTA Parent/Student Night in MTA's classrooms and labs at NMC's Parsons-Stulen building, 2600 Aero Park Drive in Traverse City (see map below.) These will be scheduled for January and beyond. Call MTA or ask your counselor to find out about dates.

2. Send in an application packet to:

The packet should include:



- a completed MTA application form,
- transcripts for 9th and first semester of 10th grade
- a paragraph explaining why you'd like to be accepted into the MTA program
- two letters of recommendation (only one of which can be from an educator)*

** Letters of recommendation do not necessarily have to accompany the application form; they can be sent in later.*

3. Interview with an MTA Manufacturer's Council member.

Once your packet has been received, you will be contacted to arrange an interview. After the interview, you will be contacted regarding the status of your application and notified about the exact date for the MTA Orientation Night, which will be held before the school year starts.
