SCHOLARSHIP SPECIFICS

- There will be a *maximum* of three recipients awarded.
- Each chosen recipient will be awarded up to \$2,500. The monies will be distributed directly to the recipient's academic institution of choice.
- Scholarship will be awarded at our TBAISD Career-Tech Center Awards Night.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

- Must be a graduating high school senior.
- Must be completing a minimum of one full year at the Career-Tech Center in any program.
- Must have an overall G.P.A of 2.75 and 3.0 G.P.A within the respective CTC program.
- Must not have ANY unexcused absence(s) in senior year.
- Must have earned and received full credit for all classes each semester at the Career-Tech Center.
- Must include a copy of the applicant's official high school transcript.
- Must complete a 300 word (minimum) essay describing your leadership capacity and how it has related to at least one area of student life.
- Must have applied to, been accepted to, and be committed to attending an accredited institution of higher learning – vocational institutions included. Letter of acceptance to this institution must accompany application.
- Must have a demonstrated financial need.
- Must provide a copy of Federal Student Aid Report page showing your EFC.
- First generation college students are preferred.
- Must provide two letters of recommendations that speak to your leadership, work ethic, and academic or work-related skills.
- Finalist must interview before the selection committee.
- Please include a wallet sized portrait of yourself with this application. Please print your name and home school district on the back of the picture. This picture is for publication purposes and will not be used in the judging process.
