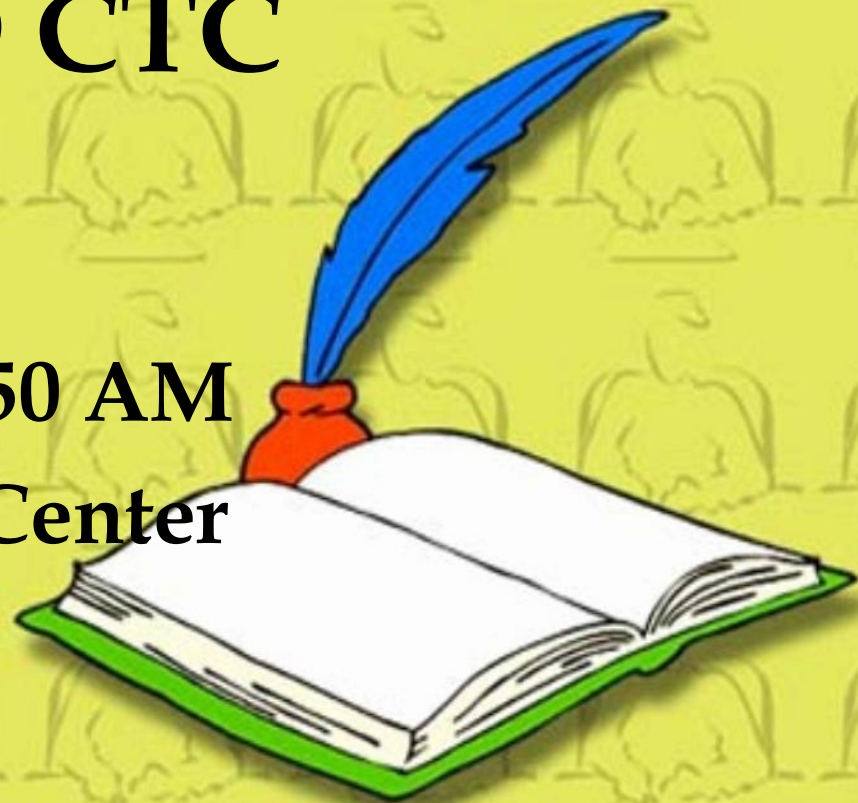

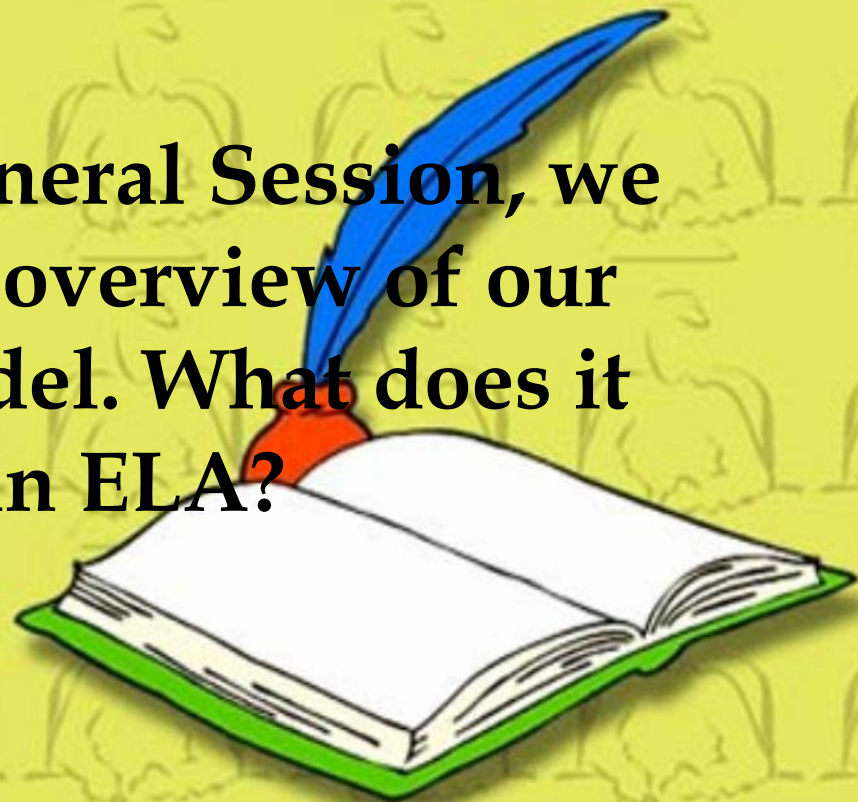

CTC staff members went to all lengths to get students to “buy in”!

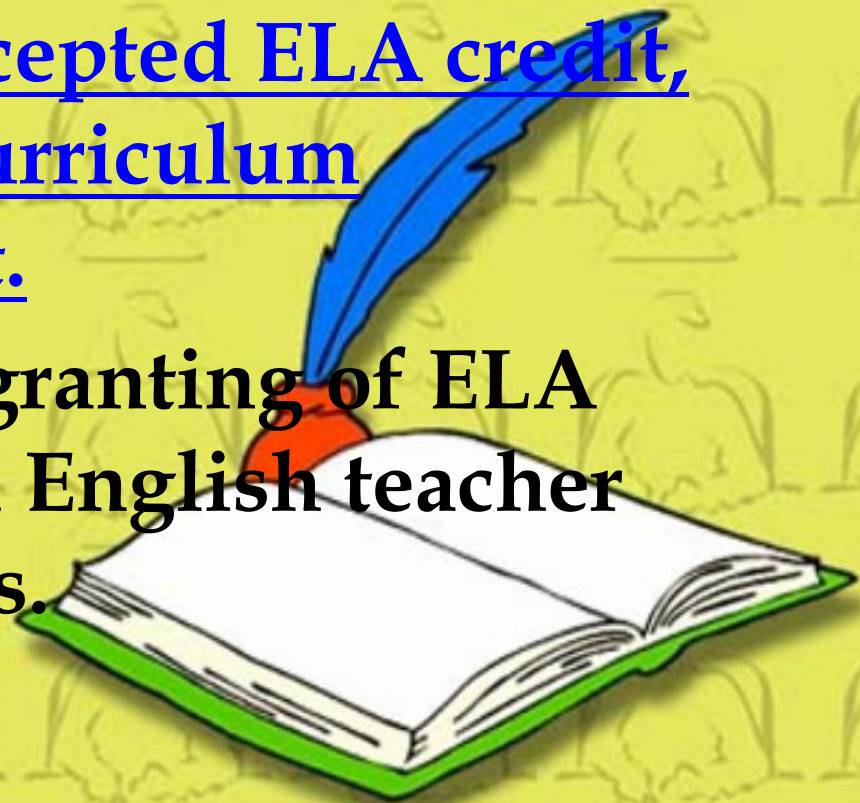

Michigan Merit Curriculum ELA Offerings at TBAISD CTC

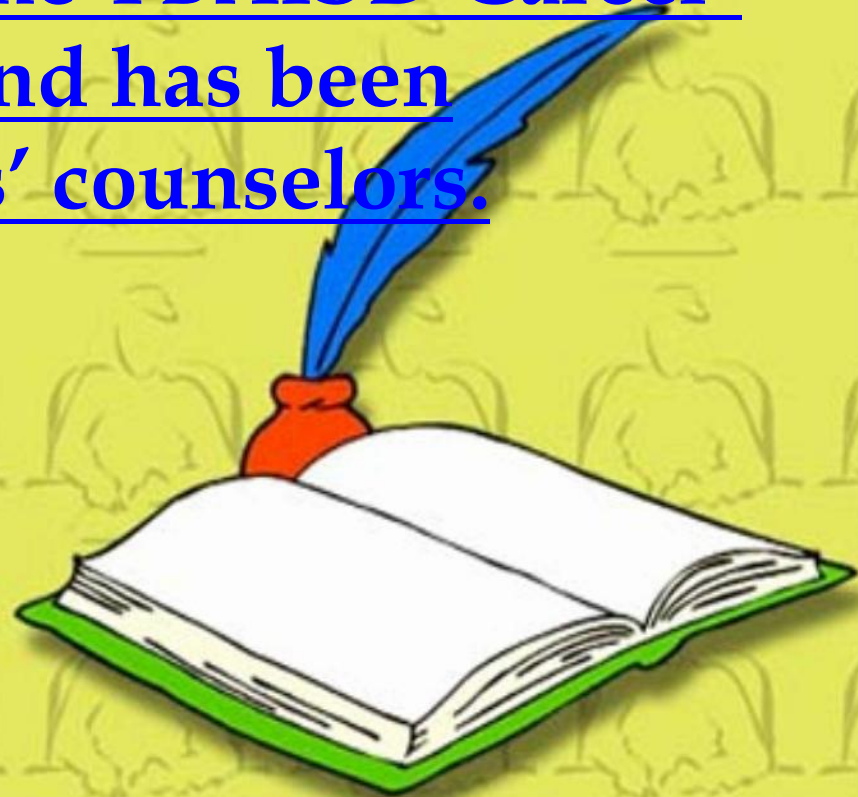
Over the past ten years, the academic offerings have evolved.....

- Prior to 2009, LEAs accepted ELA credit, based on Michigan Curriculum Framework alignment.
- In past several years, granting of ELA credit required HQ'ed English teacher and delivery of HSCEs.



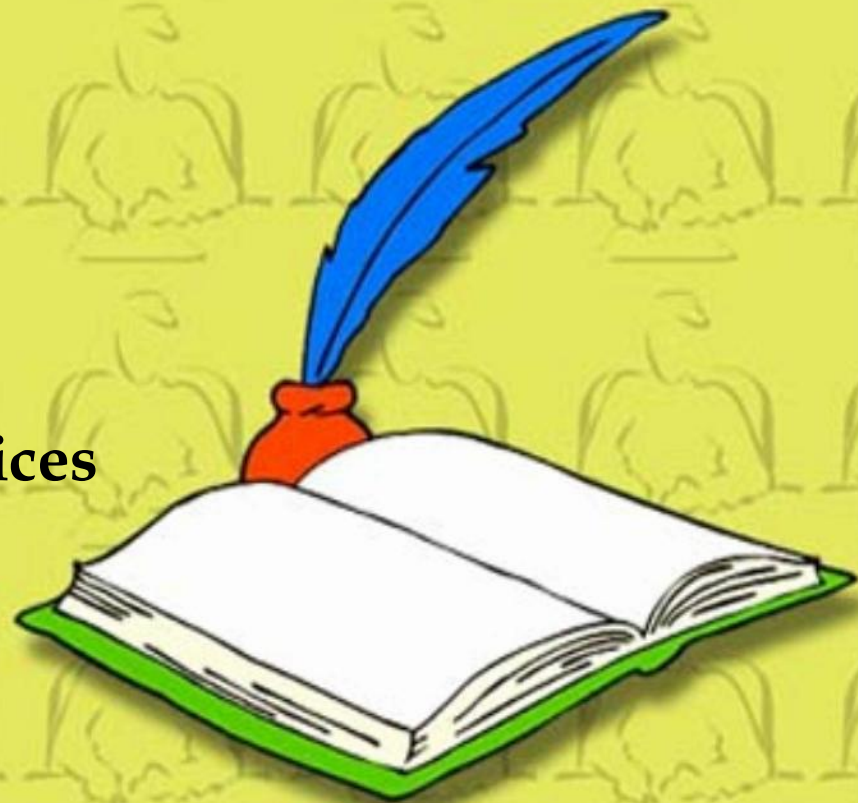
As a result, TBAISD develops a Michigan Merit Curriculum Offerings Chart

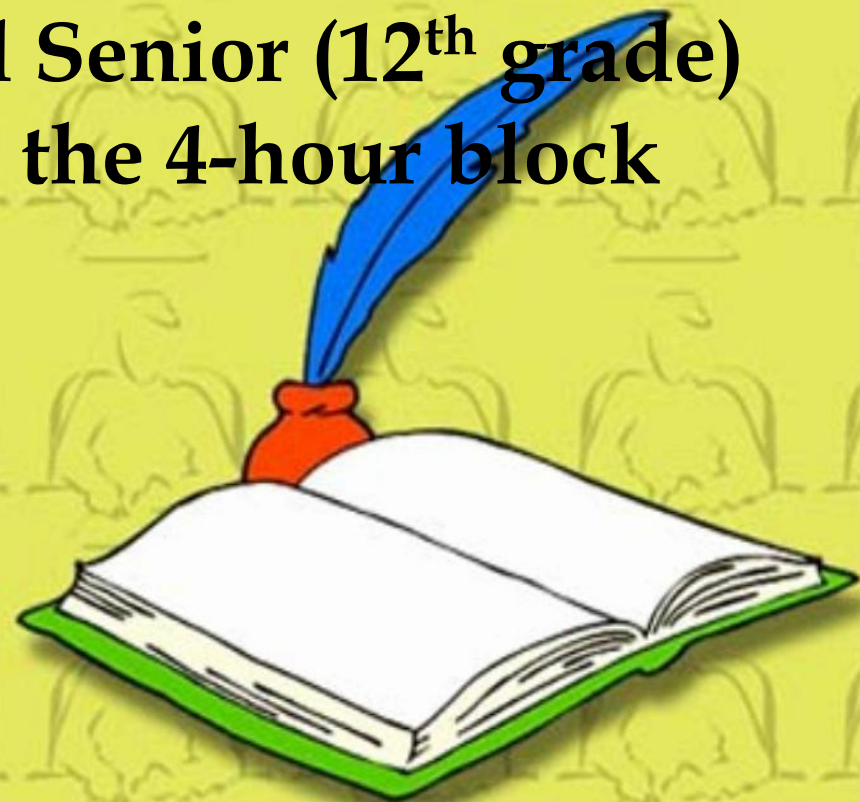

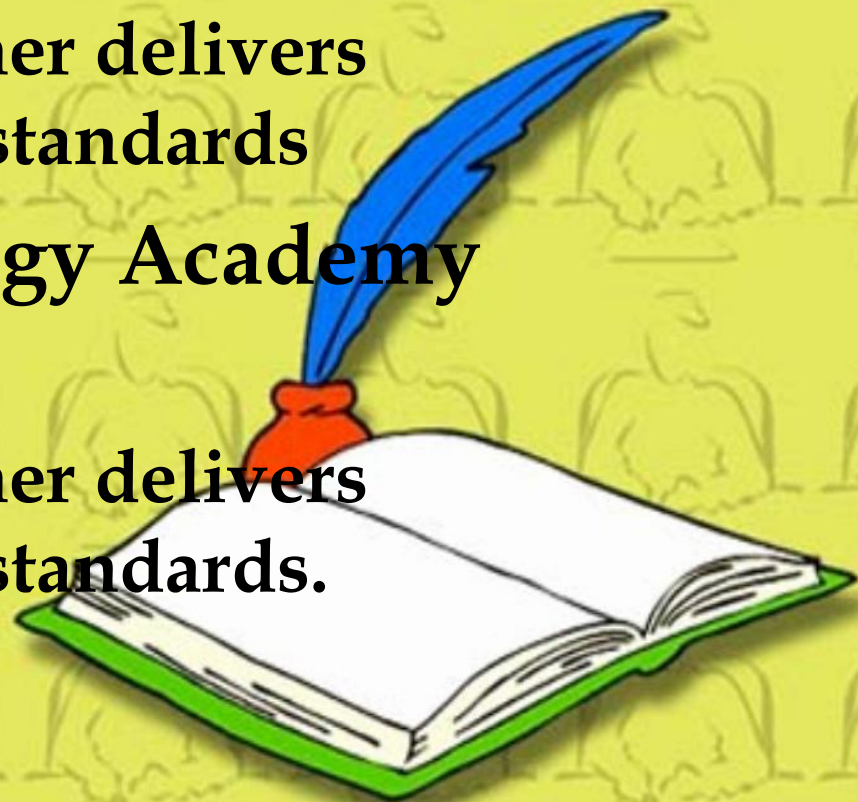
Manufacturing Technology Academy

- Extended day model – established in 1996
- Junior (11th grade) and Senior (12th grade) ELA offered as part of the 4-hour block



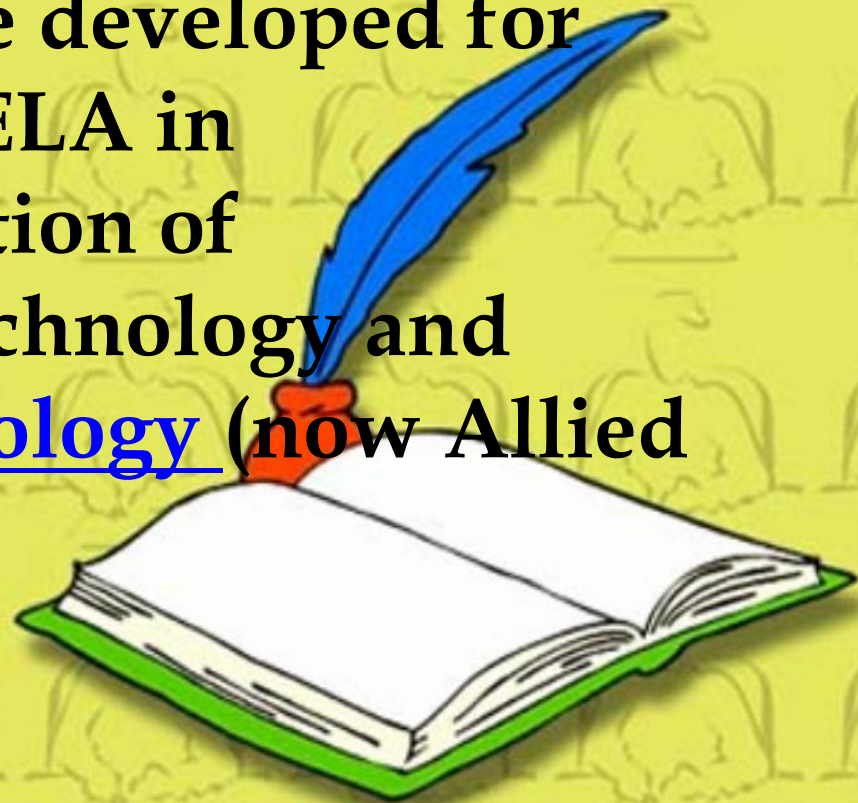
Another Academy Model

- **Auto Technology Academy**
 - Established in 1997
 - Certified English teacher delivers instruction aligned to standards
- **Information Technology Academy**
 - Established in 1999
 - Certified English teacher delivers instruction aligned to standards.



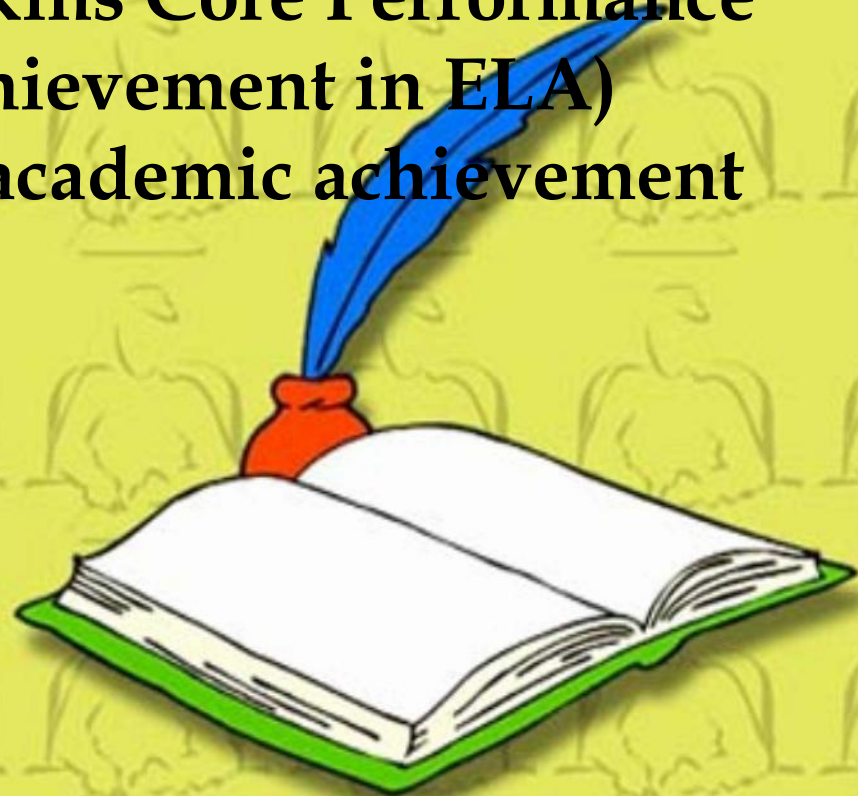
As a result of work with OCTE and the Collaborative Teaching Model...

- Two pilots begin to be developed for delivering 12th grade ELA in Entrepreneurship portion of Accounting/Office Technology and Health Science Technology (now Allied Health)



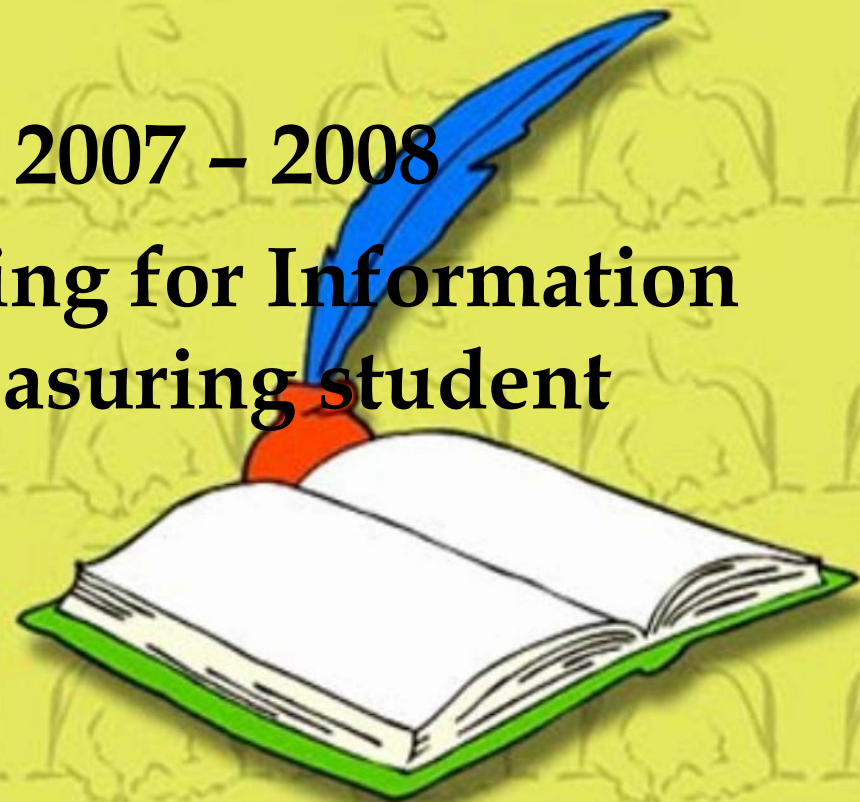
In Addition to Providing Academic Credit Options....

- CTC recognizes its role in helping the LEAs make certain “no child is left behind” and make AYP as well as Perkins Core Performance Indicators (Academic Achievement in ELA) and has established two academic achievement goals.....**



Formation of ELA Goal Teams Focused on Student Achievement

- Jason Jeffrey met with all technical instructors to determine student achievement focus.
- Goal Teams Formed - 2007 - 2008
- ACT WorkKeys Reading for Information Test to be used for measuring student achievement increase.

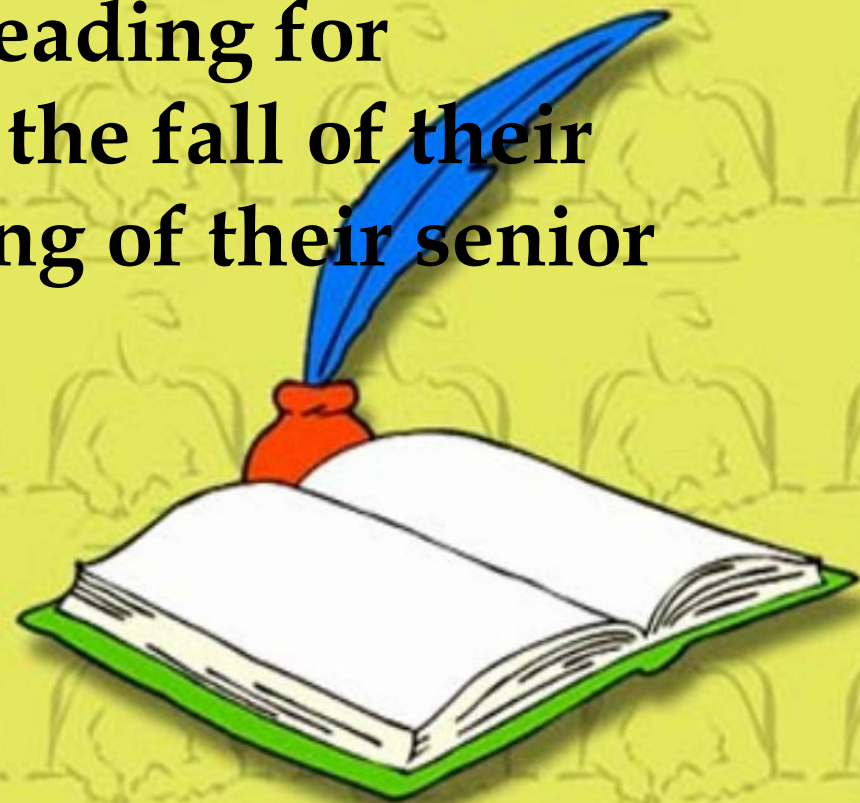

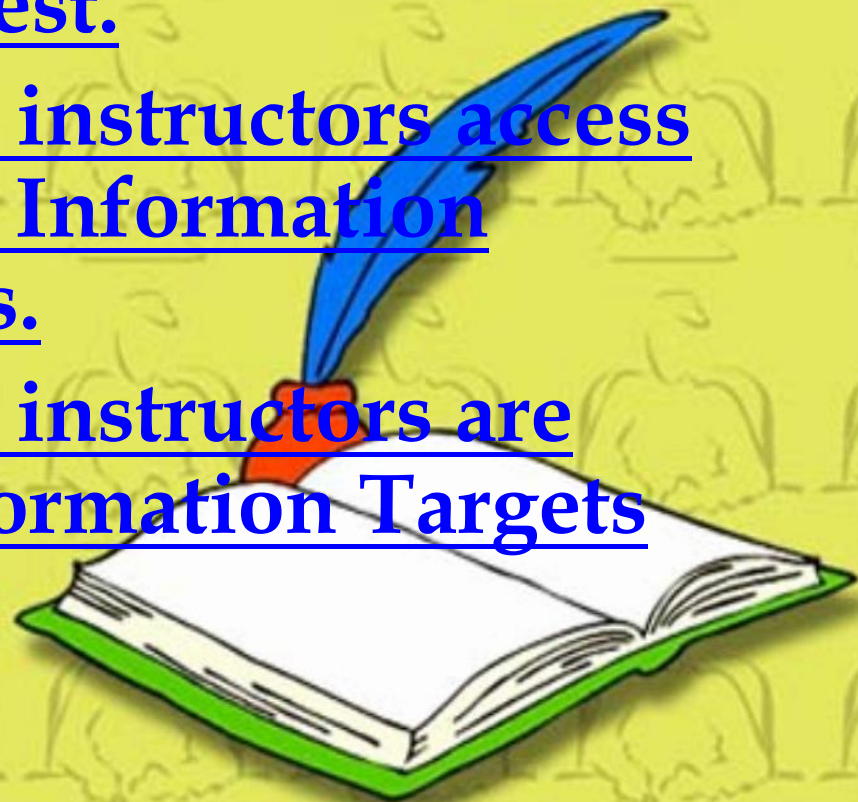
Student Achievement – ELA Goal

- 95% of students within ELA-focused programs will increase achievement on the ACT WorkKeys Reading for Information test from the fall of their junior year to the spring of their senior year.



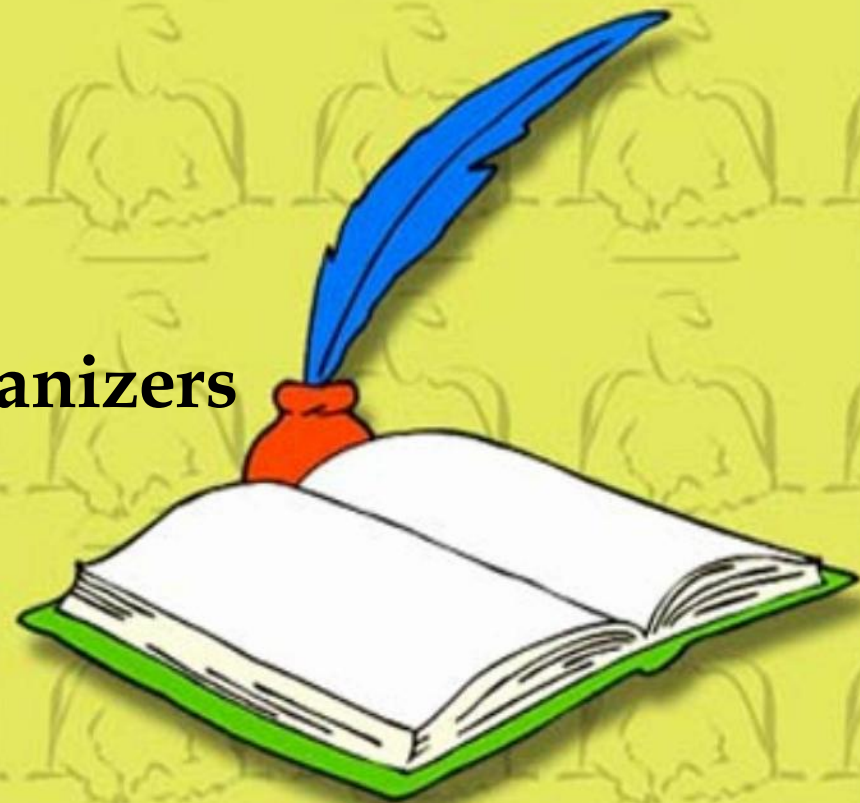
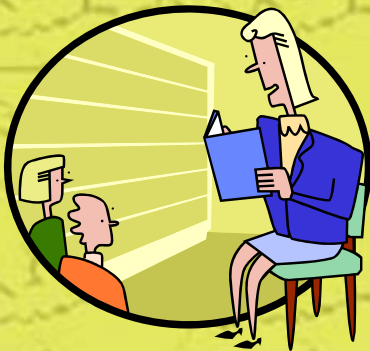
ACT WorkKeys Reading for Information

- All ELA and technical instructors take on-line ACT WK Reading for Information practice test.
- All ELA and technical instructors access KeyTrain Reading for Information instructional materials.
- All ELA and technical instructors are given Reading for Information Targets for Instruction.



ELA Goal Team works to develop classroom interventions....

- Use of KeyTrain as part of ELA instruction – web-based or adapted
- Reading Strategies
 - K-W-L
 - Highlighted Reading
 - Mapping/Graphic Organizers

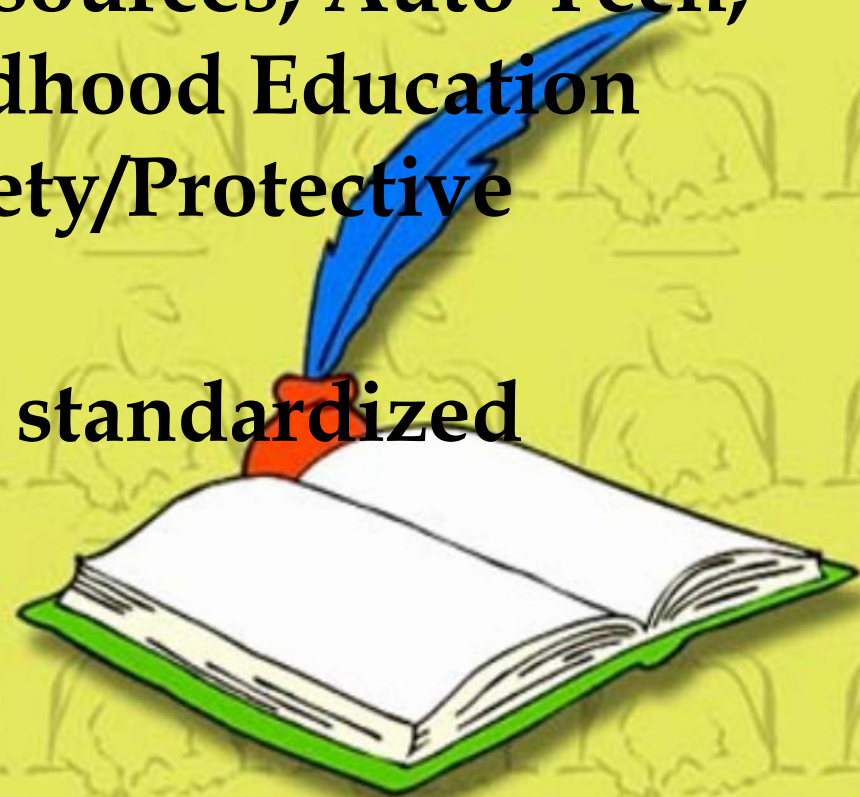
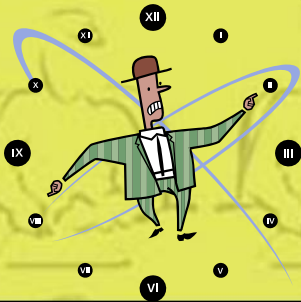


During this time (2007-2009).....

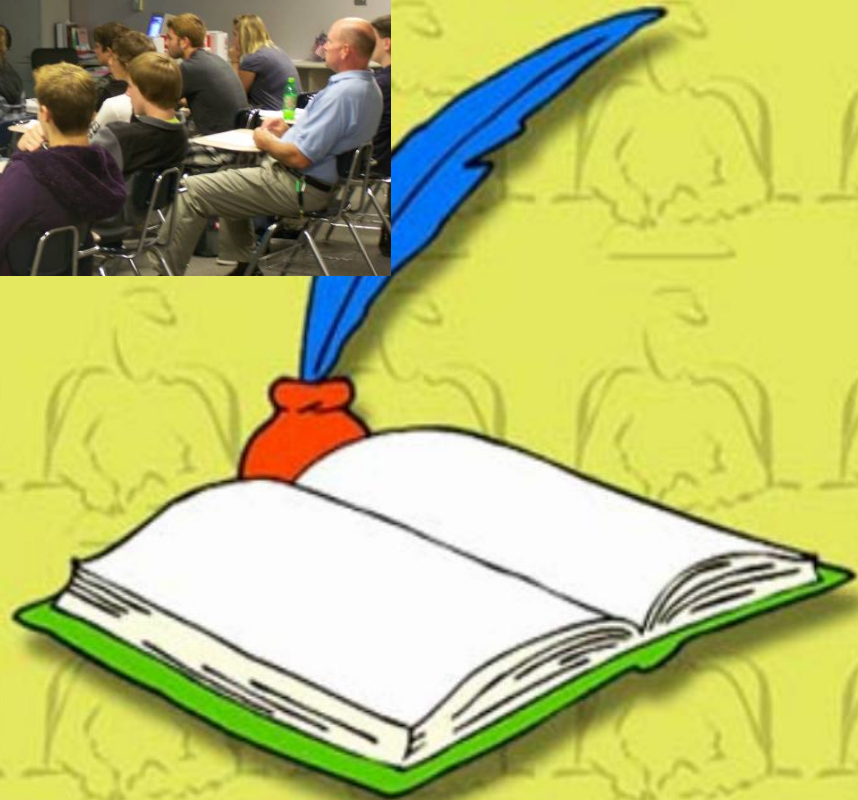
- Four additional programs begin ELA pilots:

- **Grade Determination – standardized throughout Center**



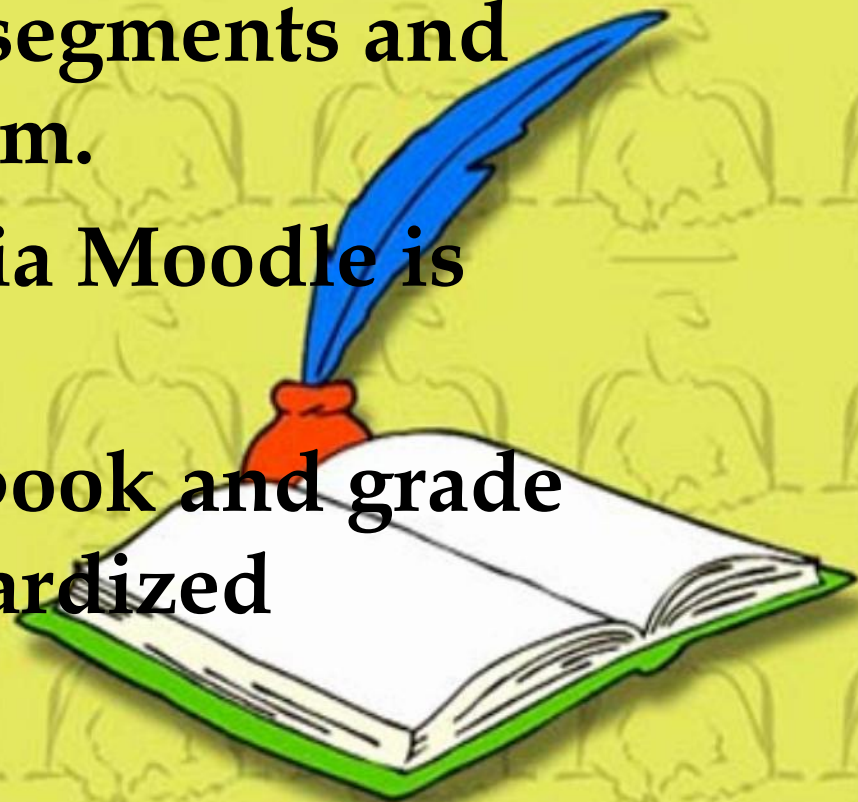
ELA and Technical Instructors Collaborate





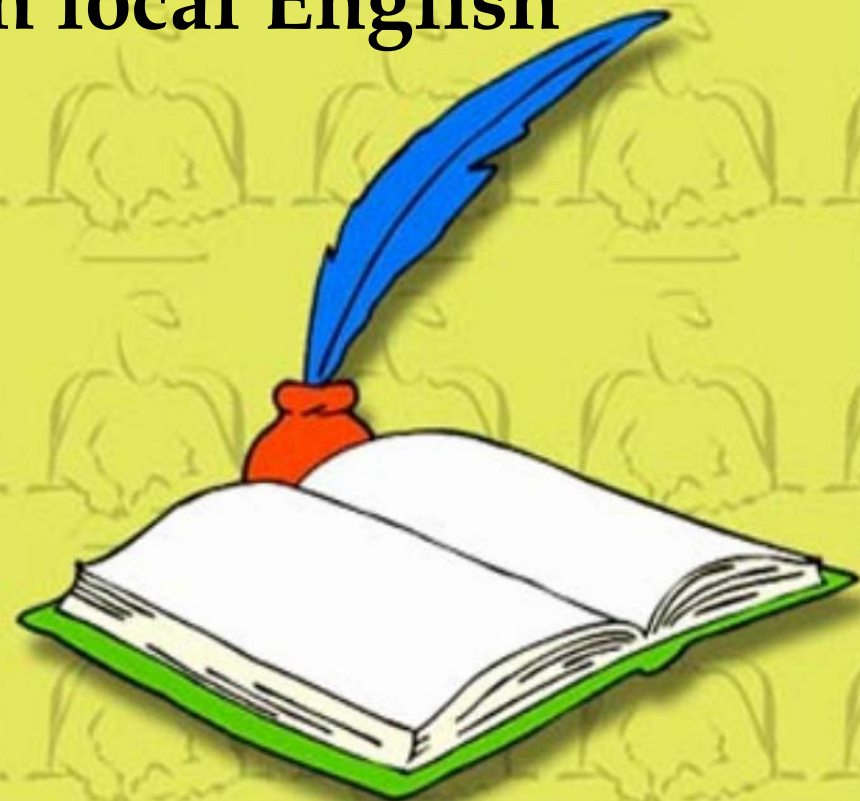
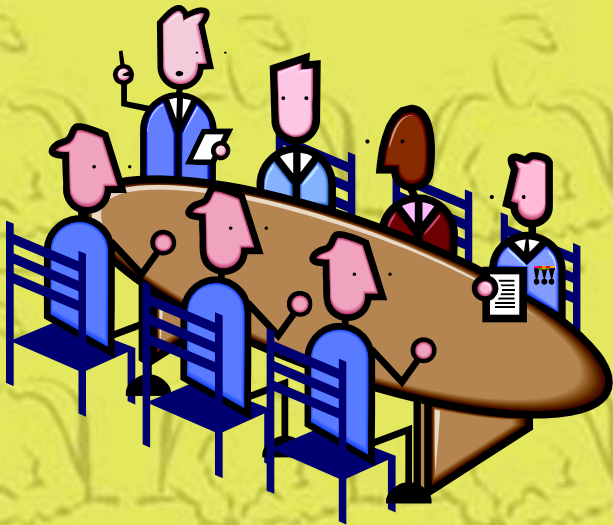
Curriculum Camp 2009

- **PowerTeacher Gradebook and grade determination - standardized**



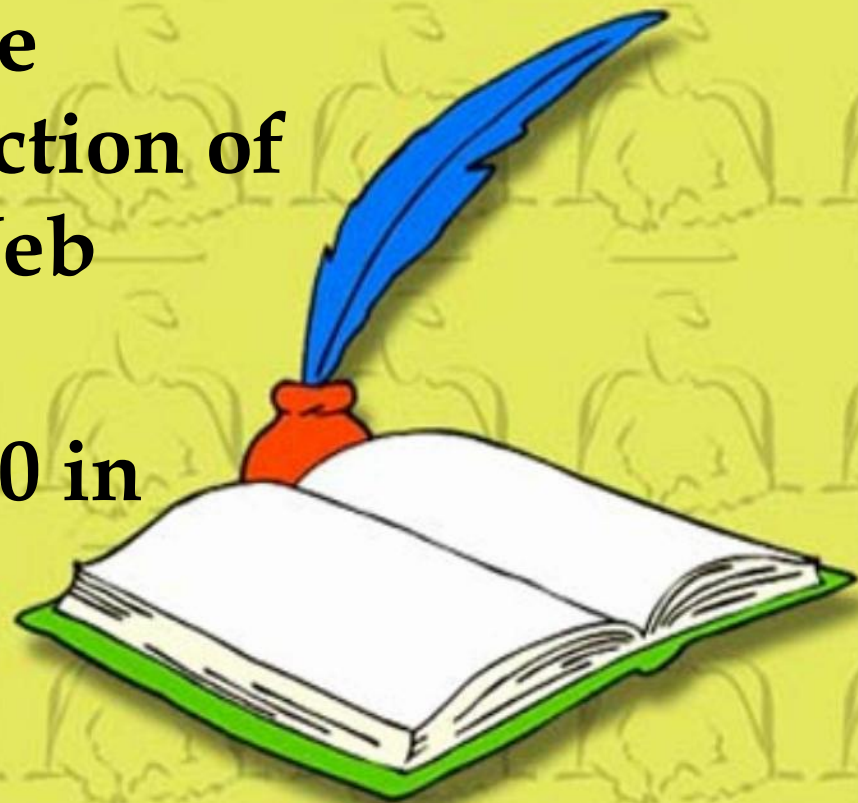
Extending Relationships

- TBAISD Career-Tech Center ELA teacher serves on TBAISD Secondary Literacy Committee, along with local English teachers.

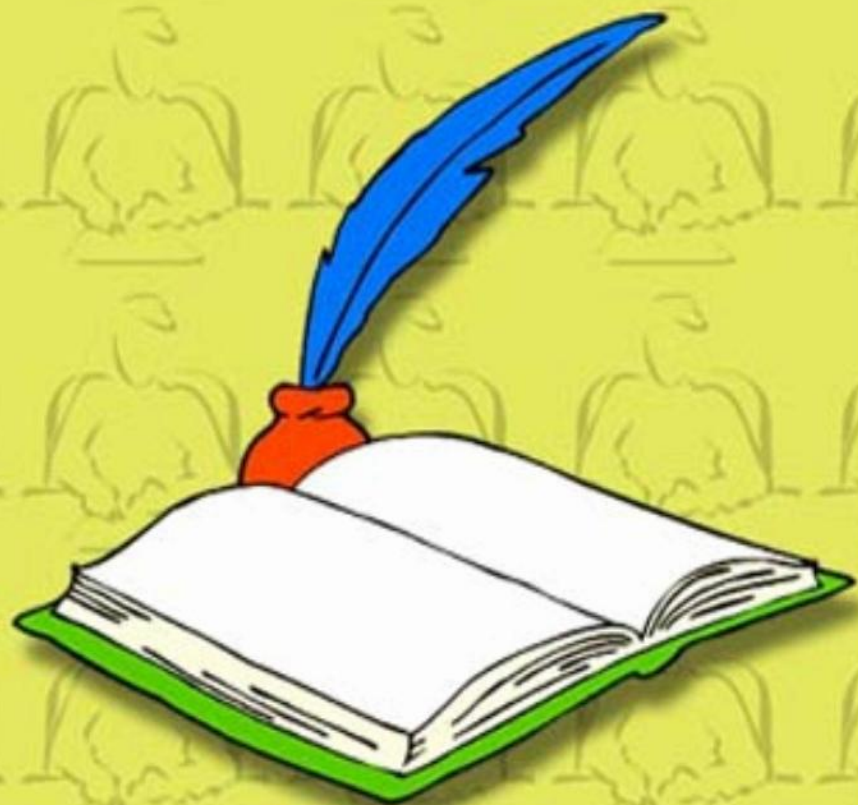


What's Next for 2010-2011?
