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STUDENT HOURS REPORT POLICY AGREEMENT

Students enrolled at the TBA Career-Tech Center and placed as a co-op/work experience student are required to turn in a Student Hours Report card to their instructor or Student Services Office, on a weekly basis. This form must show total hours worked each day at their co-op/work experience position. It must be filled out completely and signed by their supervisor. The Student Hours Report is due on the students related instruction day at the Career-Tech Center.

In the event the Student Hours Report is not turned in on the due date, the student will be allowed a one week grace period (three day grace period at the end of each semester). If these conditions are not met, all of the days the student was absent from class will be counted as personal absences. It is important to remember that students are allowed five personal absences before credit reduction begins.

**** If the student continually fails to turn in the Student Hours Report card weekly, they may be temporarily removed from the work site (up to 5 days), or be subject to permanent removal from the co-op/ work experience.**

The signing of this agreement constitutes the acceptor's agreement to comply with the above listed conditions.
