



2017 CTC Academic Scholarship

Purpose: The CTC Academic Scholarship is for students who are attending college or other types of technical training following high school. Scholarship awards are to be used for tuition, books and other expenses incurred at the post-secondary institution. Scholarships must be used during the 2017-2018 school-year.

Amount: \$500 - \$1,000

Eligibility:

- Senior
- Attended CTC for the full 2016-2017 school-year
- B or higher grade in CTC program for first semester 2016-17
- B or higher grade for the academic portion of CTC program (i.e. ELA, Algebra, etc.)
- Earned full credit for first semester of 2016-2017 school-year

Requirements:

- Complete the application online at www.tbactc.org/general-info/scholarships.asp
No handwritten applications will be accepted.
- Two letters of recommendation (may use CTC Recommendation Form)
- Copy of an acceptance letter from a college or technical school
- Current resume
- All documents attached to the cover sheet.

**Due: Applications must be turned into Student Services by 3:00 PM
Friday, March 17, 2017**

Late or incomplete applications will not be considered.

Interviews:

After selection committee reviews all applications, an interview will be scheduled for qualified applicants. Interviews will be scheduled on **Monday and Tuesday, April 10 and April 11, 2017**. At the interview, the applicant will be asked to give a short presentation demonstrating a skill the applicant learned in the CTC program. Professional dress and demeanor are an important part of the interview.
